Class Descriptions – Fall 2017

iPad & iPhone: During this 4-week iPad & iPhone class you will learn the basic features of the iPad & iPhone with emphasis on communicating with family & friends using your Apple devices. We will cover email, texting, Facetime, Skype, and taking & sharing photos and videos. The class will cover the features of the built-in apps, downloading and updating apps from the apps store, surfing the net, backing up your data to iCloud, and wireless operations. The Learning center is wireless, so students are encouraged to bring in their iPads & iPhones for hands-on instruction.

Android Smart Phone & Tablet: During this 4-week Android Smart Phone & Tablet class you will learn the basic features of your Smart Phone & Tablet with emphasis on communicating with family & friends using your Android devices. The class will cover the features of the built-in apps, downloading and updating apps from the apps store, surfing the net, backing up your data & wireless operations. Your introduction to Windows 10: Windows 10 has the features you've liked and used in Windows 7 and 8.1. But it's faster, more secure, and has easier personalization controls so you can enjoy using your computer more – and think less about the mechanics of operating it. We'll talk about what's new and useful, and present the basics you'll need to get yourself up and running. Genealogy Family Tree Maker: During this 4-week course, you will learn how to discover and organize your family history, find existing research on your ancestors, explore the world of genealogy on the Internet. and input the information into genealogy computer programs, such as the popular Family Tree Maker. The class will explore Genealogy web sites with emphasis on Ancestry.com, a popular website to help you discover and record your Family's Story. The small class size provides personal assistance and guidance using your Ancestry.com subscription. Bringing a laptop or flash drive to retain your data is recommended. *Instructor: Bob Cebulski*
